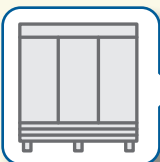
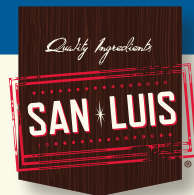


HOW-TO INSTRUCTIONS

PAPER WRAPPED HANDLING



STORAGE

- 1 Keep all product in freezer until ready to thaw.
- 2 All product has a **9-month** frozen shelf life from the production date printed on the case.
- 3 Rotate your product so that the first product in is the first product pulled out.

** Use Julian date on product if no case is present.*



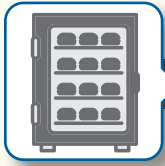
THAWING AND REFRIGERATED MERCHANDISING

- 1 Thaw product by either placing whole case or desired number of products in refrigerator for **24 hours**.
- 2 Code date when removing product from freezer and price if necessary.
- 3 Once product has thawed in refrigerator for 24 hours, product may be moved to display cases. Check to ensure temp. is 35°F-40°F in display.
- 4 Move all existing product to front of display case. Remove all expired product. Make sure each facing is at least four sandwiches deep.

PREPARATION, MICROWAVE AND MERCHANDISING

- 1 Turn on Wisco Warmer and set dial to **4**. Food safety: Unit must be set to **4** to maintain internal product temperature of $\geq 140^{\circ}\text{F}$ (reference *MN Food Code 4626-0360*).
- 2 Allow warmer to preheat for 30 minutes without product.
- 3 Microwave 4 items at once based on the time chart below.
- 4 Using sanitized temperature probe, check internal temperature of the product. Food safety: Internal Temperature must be $\geq 165^{\circ}\text{F}$ (reference *Federal Food Code 3-403.11(A)*).
- 5 On back label, mark when product is to be removed from the warmer if not sold.
- 6 Maximum time in warmer for all items is **2 hours**.
- 7 Regularly check warmer to ensure guidelines are being met.

HEATING 4 PRODUCTS AT A TIME

Heating Time	Thawed Product
2:15-3:30 Minutes	Deli Express® Breakfast & Lunch Sandwich Items
3:30-4:00 Minutes	Market® Breakfast Sandwich Items
3:45 Minutes	San Luis® Breakfast Burritos

Remember to check the internal temperature of all sandwiches. Cook times vary depending on sandwich variety and microwave wattage.

For individual sandwich cook times, please read the package label.



TURBO CHEF TORNADO PREPARATION – MARKET SANDWICH

- 1 To heat the product, start with a completely thawed sandwich at refrigerated temperature.
- 2 Open the package and place the sandwich on the **TurboChef** mesh basket lined with parchment paper.
- 3 For a toasted top bun, remove the top and place it next to the sandwich with the bottom of the bun facing up.
- 4 Once it is done cooking, remove carefully from **TurboChef** as the sandwich will be hot.
- 5 Adjust cook time using 5 second intervals to heat sandwich shorter or longer.
- 6 Other settings can be adjusted at user's discretion.
- 7 All of these directions are for the **TurboChef Tornado**.
 - For other TurboChef models or manufactures, please start with chicken sandwich or breakfast sandwich recipe and adjust until desired.
